- (c) Judas Iscariot?

18C What did Jesus do in the Garden of Gethsemane?

18D Did Jesus struggle and try to escape when the soldiers came to arrest him?

18E Was Jesus willing to die on the cross?

18F Write out 2 Corinthians 5:15. What does it mean?
